## altostratus cloud

in atmospheric chemistry

A grey, uniform, striated or fibrous sheet but without halo phenomena, and through which the sun is seen only as a diffuse, bright patch or not at all; usually at elevations 2000 m - 6000 m; vertical velocities of  $0.05 \text{ m s}^{-1} - 0.1 \text{ m s}^{-1}$ .
