capillary column

in chromatography

A general term for columns having a small diameter. A capillary column may contain a packing or have the stationary phase supported on its inside wall. The former case corresponds to packed capillary column while the latter case corresponds to an opentabular column. Due to the ambiguity of this term its use without an adjective is discouraged.
