in atmospheric chemistry

Airborne solid particles in the atmosphere which are of natural or manmade origin and which remain in suspension for some time; in the United Kingdom the size of the grit particles is defined as greater than 75  $\mu$ m in diameter (retained on a 200 mesh British Standard sieve).
