pinacols

Tetra(hydrocarbyl)ethane-1,2-diols, $R_2C(OH)$ – $(OH)R_2$, of which the tetramethyl example is the simplest one and is itself commonly known as pinacol (benzpinacol is the tetraphenyl analogue).
