

## mixed labelled

A specifically labelled compound is referred to as mixed labelled when the isotopically substituted compound has more than one kind of modified atom e.g.  $\text{CH}_3\text{-CH}_2\text{-}^{18}\text{O}$  [ $^2\text{H}$ ].
